The names on the docket sheet represent all those ~~who~~ have land settlement allotments who have applied for priority - a comparatively small number.

No doubt we shall have further applications, and it will be necessary to decide whether they are to be granted or refused. I think that if granted it should only be done in the ordinary way, i.e. without antedating to Sept. 1st; but, assuming that the priority system is continued, I think we should be quite justified in refusing to consider applications for persons who did not take the trouble to avail themselves of this chance.

As regards this list, one or two of the applications require comment.

(1) Mr. Moresby White, whose letter to Mr. Bottomley is attached, evidently did not receive our circular, though it was sent to him at the address given.

It has been decided that persons who were allotted farms under the East Africa Land Settlement Scheme, and who were unable to travel to East Africa on the S.S. "Dart Castle", may, if they desire it, be placed on the priority lists of the Dart Castle Mail Steamship Company and the British India Steam Navigation Company with effect from the 1st of September, 1919.

This concession will apply also to the wives and children of allottees, but in view of the preliminary difficulties and delay of settlement it is desirable wherever possible that wives and children should remain at home for the present.

The concession will not apply to nurses, servants, or other members of their families than wives and children, nor will it apply to the partners of allottees who are on the farm.

It must be understood that berths are allotted by the Shipping Companies according to the order of registration on the priority lists. The Colonial Office does not control the allocation of berths and no promise can be given that passages will be allotted by any particular date. As soon as berths are booked by one Company, the other Company should be informed that accommodation is no longer required.

Persons wishing to take advantage of this offer should complete the form enclosed and return it to the Colonial Office on or before the 1st of January, 1920.
