The names on the docket sheet represent all those ~~who have~~ land settlement allottees who have applied for priority - a comparatively small number.

No doubt we shall have further applications, and it will be necessary to decide whether they are to be granted or refused. I think that if granted it should only be done in the ordinary way, i.e. without amending the Act. But, assuming that the priority system is continued, I think we should be quite justified in refusing to consider applications for persons who did not take the trouble to avail themselves of this chance.

As regards this list, one or two of the applications appear convenient.

(1) Mr. Moresby White, whose letter to Mr. Bottomley is attached, evidently did not receive our circular, though it was sent to him at the address given.

I submit a draft for Mr. Bottomley's signature.

(2) Mr. C. & H. Shaw's brother is not an

allotted, and is therefore to be considered as
a partner, and is ineligible for priority. *Off. here.*

(3) W.H. Bailey Capt. G. Bailey says he is
on the M.C. priority list, but we do not
seem to have a record of it, though his
^{spouse} has been since 1918 (see below).

? Simply put them on the list without
comment.

(4) Mr. H.B. Twosey & family have been
recommended, but not as from 1st Sept.,
so they may as well go on the list with
a marginal note.

(5) Mr. Hobycote Whitmore has gone out, so that
his wife should be recommended in the
ordinary way for priority as the wife of
a resident (See decision & case of Mrs. Brown off. 1st
July 1919).

ship Navigation Company with effect from the 1st of September, 1919.


This concession will apply also to the wives and children

will it apply to the partners of allottees to work on the farm.

It must be understood that berths are allotted by the
Shipping Companies according to the order of registration on
the Priority lists. The Colonial Office does not control the
allocation of berths and no promise can be given that passages
can be allotted by any particular date. As soon as berths are
granted by one Company, the other Company should be informed
that accommodation is no longer required.
