I am directed by the Minister of Pensions to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant, and in reply to your enquiry regarding the above named widow, I am to inform you that she may be given a gratuity on remarriage equal to one year of her widow's pension under Article 11 of Royal Warrant of 1918. The widow's Flat Rate Pension under Article 11 would be 15/- per week. Allowance for the child under Article 12 would be continued after remarriage, and would be 8/8 per week to 2nd September 1919 and thereafter 10/- per week.
