I have to thank you for your letter of the 4th instant,
No. 62405 advising that you have been good enough to telegraph
to the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, enquiring whether the
instructions, which we sent to the Bank at Nairobi, as to payment
of the sum of £2,447. 13. 2 to the Government, have been acted upon.

What we particularly desire to know is whether the amount due
to the Government in respect of the transactions referred to with
Mr. Cartwright has been discharged, and it occurs to us that the
telegram, if sent in the form of your letter, does not quite make
the point plain. Unless you consider it unnecessary, we shall be
obliged if you will despatch a further telegram at our expense.


