my former employment which was "cyaniding and
gold ore Smelting" on the "Shamva Gold Mine"; which
was really hard work, and that I shall have to
take up lighter work, this is the reason I applied
for a Civil Appointment as I feel sure I could give
satisfaction, never having failed in any employment

I served on the Repatriation after the Boer War,
in charge of "Waterberg Dist", on the Transvaal

England and will presumably not be serving
again in view of the termination of hostilities
the necessity for replacement of kit does not

Office, I am wondering if the D.M.L. expected
