I reply to your letter 2273/19 of 17/1/19.

It is evident I shall never be fit enough to resume my former employment which was "lyariding and Gold ore Smelting" on the "Shamva Gold Mine", which was really hard work, and that I shall have to take up lighter work, this is the reason I applied for a Civil Appointment as I feel sure I could give satisfaction, never having failed in any employment I have taken up.

I served on the Repatriation after the Boer War, in charge of "Waterberg Dist", on the Transvaal Native Census and Locust Dept. I received a letter thanking me for my services.

I have seen your Medical Adviser, and no doubt by now you will have received his report.

(3) I have a copy of the order of my promotion to a Commission which dates from 5-1-17 (within establishment) Authority A.M.S. 1046/35, dated 8/1/17. Second portion of (pat) in your letter noted.

(4) I have received from D.M.L. Daresalam following "As this Officer (myself) has been invalided to England and will presumably not be serving again in view of the termination of hostilities the necessity for replacement of hit does not exist unless a certificate can be produced showing that he had already re-equipped himself.

This surely should have gone through your Office, I am wondering if the D.M.L. expected me to go about naked, I forwarded you certificate of replacement of hit and Claim which was considerably less than my loss and also less than it has cost me to replace by half the amount.
