Reference 58862/1919. I note that the Medical Advisor recommends that I should not return to East Africa and I am quite willing to follow his advice and to remain in this country.

Reference 59529/1919. Paragraph 1. I note that my return fare from Lincoln to London, 32/3 is to be refunded to me.

Paragraph 2. I note that I am entitled to pay at the rate of 12/- per day from 1st Feb to 21st February 1919 inclusive, and of 6/- per day from 22nd Feb 1919 until further notice. I would point out that you make no mention of Ration Allowance which I understood would be at the rate of ^d 2/1 per day from the date I left Devonport Hospital, 16th September 1919. I trust this will be included in my payments due. Payment in due course will oblige.
