Sir, I have the honor to inform you that there is a balance of pay due to me from the East African Pay Corps as Nursing Sister in the East African Nursing Service.

The balance of pay, already paid at the rate of £165 per annum from 1st April 1918 to 2^d May 1918 inclusive, also my ration allowance of 2/- per day from end of February 1918 to 6th April inclusive.

I enclose copies of correspondence which will confirm my statements and show the efforts made by the S African Pay Corp in getting off when afterwards serving as nursing sister, to obtain payment. As no settlement had been effected by the time I sailed from S Africa on 15th Feb 1919 I was advised by the Paymaster General to refer the matter to you.

Will you also kindly tell me what has gratuity I am entitled to for my service overseas in S Africa?

Reference your M.L.C. 5253/1070 of the 4th inst.

I presume you are taking further steps to obtain the necessary discharge documents. According to A 107/Int from Chief Paymaster, Nairobi, copy of which you forwarded here, Nursing Sister is entitled to pay at the rate of £1.00 per annum from 1st April to 21 days after arrival at Durban. She also claims ration of £1.00 from 2nd January to date of embarkation.

Should not her discharge have been finalised by Command Orders Nairobi ?, as Nursing Sisters do not receive discharge documents their being treated similar to Officers.

No discharge papers were forwarded with this information, however."
