I have the honor to inform you that there is a balance of pay due to me from the East African Pay Corps as Nursing Sister in the East African Nursing Service. This balance of pay should be at the rate of £165 per annum from 1st April 1918 to 31st May 1918 inclusive, also my ration allowance of 2/- per day from end of July 1918 to 6th April inclusive. I enclose copies of correspondence which will confirm my statements and show the efforts made by the East African Pay Corps in London & S. Africa afterwards send as Nursing Sister, to obtain payment. As no settlement had been effected by the time I sailed from S. Africa on 15th Feb 1919 I was advised by the Paymaster there to refer the matter to you. Will you also kindly tell me what was gradually I am entitled to for my six months service in S. Africa?

I presume you are taking further steps to obtain the necessary discharge documents. According to A.P. 14/14 from Chief Paymaster, Nairobi, copy of which you forwarded here, Nurse Farvest is entitled to pay at the rate of £15 per annum from 1st April to 14 days after arrival at Durban; she also claims ration allowance from 2nd January to date of embarkation.

Should not her discharge have been granted at Command Quarters Nairobi?, as Nursing Sisters do not receive discharge documents they being treated similar to officers.
