I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of your communication ¹⁰⁰ 29776/1917 of 6th inst. enclosing cheque for £79-1-0 in the ex gratia fund in pay as Lt. in the East African Force.

I beg to point out that I have, as a Lt. in the East African Force, not been appointed a Major in the East African Force - and as per copies of my pay list, herewith enclosed I am paid as a Staff Captain and further that by London Gazette 19.12.16 (supplement 20.12.16) I am app^d Comm^d & Class (Precedent for purposes of pay as Staff Captain) and to be Temp^r Maj^r whilst so employed.

As to my desiring special rate of pay while serving in the Political Dept. I beg to point out that by Dentine orders D.O. 4 Salen 25 May 1917 I am transferred from Pol. office to the Portuguese Consular Liaison office, Belga and further antedated to 13.10.16 by a subsequent Dentine order D.O. 4 Salen 2 June 1917.

I therefore beg that you will verify these orders and I claim the difference in gratuity

to me of that of Staff Captain for the whole
the period of my service in East Africa i.e.
