I have the honour to thank you for your letter of 27th inst. in re the premises contained in S. 3.

I do not wish to come out that from the military point of view there is a real difference between relinquishing one's commission or honor of the rank and because of a promotion or honor to substitute another rank from your own letter.

I gained the impression that you intended to relinquish my commission for the latter reason whereas your communication of 27th inst. refers

to ill-health. I shall, therefore, be glad if you will
advise me whether my opinion, and especially my interpretation
of your letter of 4th October 1918, is correct.
