I have the honour to inform you that the Crown Agents for the Colonies in sending me life certificates for completion during my absence from England state that for the month of August I am entitled to draw my pension up to 23rd. I shall be glad if you will take steps to meet this misunderstanding on their part, for, when you kindly granted me permission to carry out the medical recommendation and take a sea voyage which would make impossible for me to appear before another medical board in fact, I am sure that it was not your intention that the payments should be suspended.

Were I able to be re-examined now I am sure that report would not differ from the last. If you desire a medical certificate to this effect you could obtain one from

my doctor, R. Prichard,

who last saw me a few days before I sailed. I believe, however, that this voyage will do me a deal of good and that I shall return much better in health. Meanwhile you will, I trust, instruct the Crown Agents to continue to pay in full my monthly allowance.

I shall also be glad to hear whether the Ministry of Pensions has yet recognised my eligibility for the maximum alternative pension.

Kindly send reply to my home address, whence it will be forwarded by my parents according to the ship's future movements.
