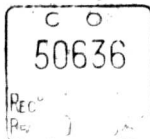

Referring to our correspondence in October last we now enclose a copy draft lease of a piece of land at Nidham, to our clients the Niagara Soda Company Limited.

On Page 3 of the draft there is a clause which reads as follows, namely:

"To hold the same unto the Lessee for the term of 99 years from the 22 day of April 1911 subject save where expressly hereafter otherwise provided to the provisions of the said various Leases Dated 1902 and especially to the provisions contained in Article 1 thereof."
