Telegram. The Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received Colonial Office 1.54 p.m. 28th January, 1915.)

January 28th fall in price of cotton having reduced purchase rate here from 6 cents to four and $\frac{1}{2}$ cultivation in Nyanza province probably will cease unless purchasers make arrangements to improve present market price. No substantial difference could be effected by reduction of railway charges. Have informed manager British East Africa Corporation accordingly.
