BAST AFRICA PROTECTORATE ORDER! IN COUNCIL, 1902.

- 25 (1) Where it is shown by evidence on oath, to the satisfaution of the Commissioner that any person is conducting himself so as to be dangerous to peace and good order in East Africa, or is endeavouring to excite enmity between the people of East Africa and His Majesty, or is intriguing against His Majesty's power and authority in East Africa the Commissioner may, if he thinks fit, by order under his hand and official seal order that person to be deported from the Protectorate to such place as the Commissioner may direct.
 - (2) The place shall be a place in some part
 (if any) of Hiz Majesty's dominions to which the
 person belongs, or the Government of which consents
 to the reception of persons deported under this
 Order, or to some place under the protection of
 His Majesty.
