904 964 I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch Ne.84 of the 3rd of February on the subject of the Return of Special Warrants for the quarter ended the 30th of June 1914, and with reference to paragraph 2 thereof, to observe that, while in the case of new services it might be possible to obtain your sanction before issuing a Special Warrant, in cases where the provision for an established service is exceeded the excess cannot be ascertained until the accounts are made up some three months later. In such instances the practice is to issue a Special Warrant when the actual excess is known, vide Colonial Office Regulation No.286.
