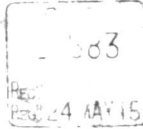

I have the honour to refer to my despatch No. 151 of the 1st ultimo, in which I brought to your notice an act of bravery performed by Assistant Superintendent E. Scott Higgins.

2. On that same occasion 2nd Grade Constable No. 2651 Ndolo wa Mbua dived into the river when he saw his comrade in difficulties and relieved him of a bag of ammunition. Mr. Higgins actually effected the rescue but this Constable made a gallant attempt to do so, and I consider that this should be brought to the notice of the Royal Humane Society.
