

Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 17th ultimo (20656/1914) and its accompanying copy of "The Public Works Loan Ordinance 1914" of the East Africa Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that My Lords concur in his proposal not to advise His Majesty to exercise his power of disallowance with respect to the Ordinance.

In this connection I am to advert to Treasury letter 2688/14 of the 25th February last and to say that it appears to My Lords to be more convenient to make the payments on account of interest and sinking fund on this loan on the same date. I am therefore to suggest that the interest should also be paid on the 1st April in each year, the adjustment being effected by the payment of an odd quarter's interest in respect of the period 31st December 1915 - 1st April 1916. If Mr. Harcourt concurs in this suggestion They will be glad if he will give directions accordingly.
