I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Read's letter of the 22nd instant (31668/1914), and its accompanying copy of a letter from the Crown Agents for the Colonies relating to the financial position of the East Africa Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Hargourt that My Lords have given directions for the immediate issue of a sum of £32,000 to the account of the Crown Agents for the Colonies as a further instalment on account of the loan of £250,000 from Imperial funds for the Nairobi-Thika Railway and other works.

I am to take this opportunity of saying that My Lords would be glad to have an answer at Mr. Hargourt's convenience to the second paragraph of the Treasury letter (9462/14) of the 15th May last on the question of the adjustments of the annuities in repayment of these advances.
