THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1916.STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The Customs Tariff Amendment Ordinance, 1916, has been enacted in pursuance of undertakings given to the Hairedal Electric Power and Lighting Company that electric material will be exempted from customs duty.

1. The exemption is intended to cover all material necessary for the production, storing and distribution of electric energy but not that necessary for using such energy other than industrial machinery. It is considered that it would be illogical to exempt for example electric lamps and their fittings, electric bottles and irons and to exact a duty on other lamps and on ordinary bottles and irons.
