With reference to Mr. Harcourt's despatch No. 264 of April 18th, I have the honour to inform you that Mr. Nesfield pressed for his discharge on more than one occasion as he was apparently anxious to be free to apply for a commission at home. His request was granted and he is not therefore entitled to any refund of expenses.

2. As a special concession however the General Officer Commanding suggests that a gratuity of three months' full pay might be allowed viz £24 and I support this recommendation and trust that you will be able to sanction payment accordingly.
