- The only property which appears to come under the category in question is a small freshold plot ewned by Messrs Hansing & Co., the agents for the Deutsche Ost Africa Line, en Membasa Harbour. I do not cany sider that there are any circumstances which would render its acquisities by Government desirable, nor do I think that there is any objection to its retention by its present ewners.
 - 5. There is another preparty on Membass Harbour consisting of a dwelling-house and godewns on the site of the old British Consulate known as Leven House. This is evned by Mesers O'Swald & Co., of Hamburg, and is also freeheld. They are not a shipping firm but vessels were soomsienally consigned to them. The remarks which I have made regarding Messre Hansing's plet apply in this case also.
