the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received Colonial Office, 4.45 p.m. 6th July, 1915).

No. 238. In continuation of my despatch
25th February No. 142 Turkana operations concluded in
highly satisfactory manner. Necessary garrison has
been left in district. Have arranged with Governor
of Uganda to take over administration of Turkana in
that Protectorate pending definite decision on future
boundary between two Protectorates. It will be
necessary to immediately establish four posts in
Turkana at cost of £2,000 to March 31st next. Request
authority to expend this amount from proceeds sale of
captured stock which will be ample after settling
claims of Samburu and others for stock looted by
Turkana.
