THE COCONUT TRADE ORDINANCE, 1915.

The above Bill has been recommended to the Legislative Council at the Sessions held on the 23rd ultimo in pursuance of Colonial Office No. 275 of the 21st April, 1915, in order that the words "or person in charge" should be added after the word "owner" in Section 9 (1) of the Bill as passed by the Council.

2. It appeared at the same time desirable to make a similar amendment to Section 11 of the Bill.

3. Having regard to the Secretary of State's remarks in the despatch quoted above I am of opinion that the Bill as amended by the Legislative Council on the 23rd ultimo may now be assented to and published without further reference to the Secretary of State.
