THE COURTS (EMERGENCY POWERS) AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1915.STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.The object of the Courts (Emergency Powers)

Amendment Ordinance, 1915 is to correct a misprint which has occurred in Section 2 Sub-section 3 of the Courts (Emergency Powers) Ordinance, 1915. The word "liability" in that sub-section should have been "inability". The mistake was made in the early stages of the original draft of the ordinance and has hitherto escaped detection.
