STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The object of the Courts (Emergency Powers) Amendment Ordinance, 1915 is to correct a misprint which has occurred in Section 2 Sub-section 3 of the Courts (Emergency Powers) Ordinance, 1915. The word "liability" in that Sub-section should have been "inability". The mistake was made in the early stages of the original draft of the Ordinance and has hitherto escaped detection.

It is of opinion having in view the purpose of the Ordinance that amendments be made without prior reference to the Government.
