General Officer Commanding has called attention
to a number of cases of the Army Regulations which
prohibit officers from being connected with
business concerns of firms. Such prohibition would
be a serious disadvantage to their officers and some
of the African Officers are so connected.

Enforcement of such a rule would result in resignation of
commissioned officers who are concerned cannot afford to
leave their business while refusal to accept
such a regulation combined with enforcement would cause
serious public discontent. General Officer Commanding
and I are of the opinion that under exceptional
and such conditions of business interests are
not detrimental to military efficiency. We therefore
recommend that a special committee of War Office be
appointed to examine the question of resignation
of such commission.

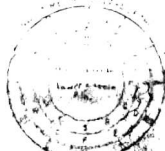

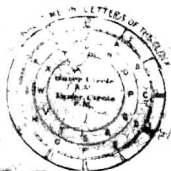
