I have the honour to report that in deference to the wishes of the General Officer Commanding, who considered such action necessary on military grounds, I have under Martial Law prohibited the immigration into the Protectorate of all Somalis.

2. The Governors of French and Italian Somaliland, the Commissioner of British Somaliland, and the French and Italian Consuls in this Protectorate have been duly notified and asked to cooperate.
