Sir,

I have the honour to report that owing to recent resignations and promotions in the Survey Department of this Protectorate it is necessary to fill forthwith the following vacant posts:-

- (a) One Junior Staff Surveyor
- (b) Three Assistant Junior Staff Surveyors
- (c) One Draughtsman.

2. I propose to fill the post of Junior Staff Surveyor by the promotion of Mr. C. A. Hall, who is at present an Assistant Junior Staff Surveyor.
