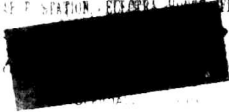
No. 354 Your telegram October 22nd. In my telegram September 30th No. 331, I stated that audit of accounts to March 31st cannot be available before middle of February. Figures required by you presumably do not include payments made by the field disbursing officer on account of troops from India, the Rhodesian contingent, and the Frontiersmen. Apart from such payments, only expenditure which it has been decided definitely to charge finally to the War Office is that for the additional King's African Rifles which was not incurred before March 31st. 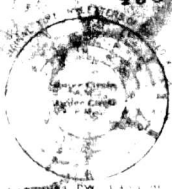

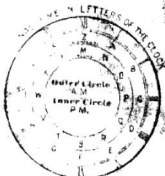
