Sir,

I have the honour to invite your consideration of the case of Juma bin Hero, Nahoda of the S.S. "Rose", plying on the Juba River.

2. This man was engaged on the 12th of July 1900 and has thus completed over 15 years service. His salary is Rs. 85/- per month.

3. He is reported by the Medical Officer Jubaland to have been suffering from facial paralysis for six months, apparently due to a haemorrhage in the brain. He is 70 years old and is not regarded as fit to carry out his duties satisfactorily.


