Sir,

I have the honour to report that it has become necessary to dispense with the services of an Indian headman, named Dossa, of the Public Works Department, owing to his age and physical incapacity for further work.

2. This man was engaged by the Imperial British East Africa Company and was transferred to Government service when the Protectorate was proclaimed in 1895. He has been employed by the Public Works Department for the last 20 years. In or about the year 1898 his face was severely injured while he was in charge of blasting operations at Mombasa, and his sight was thereby much impaired.

3. Under section 4 of the Superannuation Act of 1887, he may, by reason of his completion of


