Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram of the 17th instant regarding the method of disposing of the revenue and expenditure of the Court of Appeal for Eastern Africa.

2. The question has been also raised whether the Government of one of the other Protectorates concerned should be called upon to pay Court fees on filing an appeal. I consider that, as it has been arranged for this Protectorate to defray all expenses and to receive all revenue in respect of the Court of Appeal, such a demand cannot be considered unreasonable, and I should be glad to receive an expression of your concurrence in my opinion.
