Sir,

I have the honour to report that I have found it necessary to dispense with the services of Mr L.A. Vaz, Sub-Overseer in the Public Works Department, on the grounds of economy.

2. Mr Vaz was employed in the first instance by the Agricultural Department in 1903 and was transferred to the Public Works Department in 1905. He is now advanced in years and cannot usefully be employed in a Government Department. His work and conduct have been satisfactory throughout, and I have the honour therefore to recommend that he be granted a gratuity on retirement of £12, being £1 for each completed year of service, under Section 4 of the Superannuation Act, 1887. His salary is Rs.50 per mensem.
