THE INVENTIONS, DESIGNS AND TRADE MARKS (TEMPORARY  
RULES) ORDINANCE, 1915.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The Inventions, Designs and Trade Marks (Temporary Rules) Ordinance, 1915, has been passed in accordance with the suggestion of the Secretary of State contained in his circular despatch of the 16th April 1915 paragraph (4) after inquiries which made it clear that such legislation was desirable for the protection of traders.

2. The Bill follows the model of the Patents, Designs and Trade Marks (Temporary Rules) Act, 1914, as amended by the Patents, Designs and Trade Marks Temporary Rules (Amendment) Act, 1914. A comparative table is annexed.
3. As the Bill has been drafted in pursuance of the aforesaid circular despatch from the Secretary of State it may in my opinion be enacted without prior reference to the Colonial Office.
