

THE NATIVE HUT AND POLL TAX AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1915.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The object of the Native Hut and Poll Tax Amendment Ordinance, 1915, is to raise the maximum hut and poll tax payable by natives to Rs.5/- in such areas as the Governor may determine.

2. The Bill has been drafted with the approval

of the Secretary of State and I am therefore of opinion
that it may be enacted without further reference.
