The procedure proposed corresponds closely with that proposed in the case of Ordnance stores (S/W/4107/16 & p. 16) with the substitution of "War Expenses" for "Comma Charge Account". Medical services are very largely "Comma" and I am inclined to think that we should try to get this put on the same basis entirely as the Ordnance stores. I have included this in a draft to you on 4/107. It would mean that no medical ^{stores} ~~other charges~~ would be charged to "War Expenses".

I have the honour to transmit herewith a copy of a memorandum setting forth the arrangements made with regard to the supply by the Protectorate Medical store of medical requisites to the military forces.

2. The effect of these arrangements will be that, on the conclusion of hostilities, the Protectorate supplies will be in precisely the same position as they were on the outbreak of war. The proposals commend themselves to me as being simple and businesslike, and I have approved their adoption.
