Gentlemen,

We have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of yesterday's date, and in reply thereto would inform you that on the 18th February last a draft of the Agreement was forwarded to the Solicitors to the Syndicate containing the amendments suggested in the enclosure to your letter of the 17th February, and since that date we have been continually pressing the Solicitors for the Syndicate to return the draft approved, but they inform us that the majority of the directors are at present on active service, and they are in consequence, unable to get the matter attended to. They however informed us last week that Mr. Davis, one of the Directors of the Syndicate who has the matter in hand, was expected to return from Paris shortly, and that they then hoped that they would be able to get the draft finally settled and approved.
