
Communication from Alan Lennox

McNeely and Price, manufacturers of kid of
Mongolian have signed in the presence of his
Majesty's Consul General at Philadelphia an undertak-
ing that the hair contained purchased or to be pur-
chased from Paul A. Slipp of Adele Will, if allowed
to come forward be used exclusively for industrial
purposes in their Philadelphia factory and would not
be exported either directly or indirectly to any
country at war with Great Britain. Messrs. McNeely
have also signed a declaration in similar terms re-
pecting hair goat skins to be purchased by them from
the East African Trading Company of Mombask. They
desire that the proper Colonial Authorities be so
advised. Firm is favourably reported upon and
appears to be reliable.
