you for the information of the Government of India,  
that he has recently been in communication with  
the Vice-Admiral Colonial Forces in regard to the issue of  
instructions to the officers commanding His Majesty's  
forces in East and West Africa, with a view to the con-  
clusion of a mutual agreement with the German authorities  
in those ports for the restoration of prisoners  
of war.
