With reference to your letter No. 38517/1915 of the
25th ultimo relative to the case of MAX Klein, I am
directed by Secretary Sir E. Grey to state that he has
received confirmation of the report that the French
Government have removed the sequestration under which
the firm's establishment at Marseilles has been placed.

I am to add that there is reason to believe that
the firm will shortly comply with the regulations of
the Government of India in respect of their Aden branch
and that so far as this Department is concerned it is
not intended to take any further steps against them.
