Sir:-

With reference to my letter, 155912/15, of the 27th ultime, suggesting that an inter-departmental conference should be held to discuss the question of a naval demonstration to take place off the coast of German East Africa, I am directed by Secretary Sir Edward Grey to state that, in his opinion, it would be advantageous that this conference should meet at an early date.

I am therefore to propose that, if Mr. Secretary Bonar Law concurs, the conference should meet at this Department on the 8th instant.
