Sir,

With reference to Lord Passfield's despatch No. 200 (Reserved) of the 6th March 1930, and paragraph 18 of my despatch No. 700 (Reserved) of the 10th December last, I have the honour to transmit:-

(a) A Statement showing, Province by Province, the total actual revenue derived from the direct taxation of natives in 1930 and the total actual expenditure in 1930 on services directly benefitting the native population; and

(b) A provisional Statement showing, Province by Province, the total estimated revenue to be derived from direct taxation of natives in 1931 and the total estimated expenditure on services directly benefitting the native population.

2. These statements have been compiled on the same lines as those which were accepted in Lord Passfield's despatch No. 358 of the 8th May 1930, whilst the disability inherent in any such statements, and to which attention was drawn in Kenya despatch No. 202 of 31st March 1930, must again be emphasised.

3. I regret that the Comparative table of Estimated Revenue and Expenditure of Local Native Councils in 1932 as asked for in your despatch under reference is delayed. The Local Native Council Estimates will be submitted to Executive Council in the near future and as soon as they are finally approved the comparative table will be forwarded.
