Old Okello awarded 6 strokes under Sect 57 (19) of the Prison Ordinance. The conviction was quashed although the sentence had been carried out.

See also the case of Lotoi % Kotera (ages 16) awarded 8 strokes under section 2, Cap 76, conviction quashed although sentence had been carried out.

Cherungo was awarded 12 strokes under section 2 of the Penal Code & Sect. 14. The sections provide for imprisonment and a fine.

There are two disquieting features about this return. I shall be glad if Library can state the present law on the following points:-

(1) How far does the law require the presence of a Medical Officer? I observe that in several cases the return states that no Medical Officer was available. Under Section 61 of the Prison Ordinance of 1930, if a Medical Officer is not available, some other European officer must be present, and presumably this requirement has been observed, though the return does not say so. I suppose that Section has not been amended. If it has not been amended, it does not apply to corporal punishment awarded by a court. It is significant that in one case the prisoner was found medically unfit for the punishment awarded, and in another case the sentence was reduced on medical advice. (2) It seems altogether wrong that a sentence of corporal punishment should be carried out until it is clear that the conviction will not be quashed or reduced, i.e., until the time for appeal or review has expired. Is there anything in law to prevent this? In addition to the cases mentioned by Mr. Grossmith, it is not clear that in the case of Njeroge Karanja the full sentence awarded by the Court was not carried into effect before it was reduced by the Supreme Court.

(1) Section 61(4) of the Prisons Ordinance, 1930 (No. 37 of 1930) provides that:-

"a sentence of corporal punishment shall not be carried out except in the presence of a medical officer or, if no such medical

officer

officer is available, or a European officer of the Colony, nor before such medical or other officer has after examination certified that in his opinion the prisoner is physically fit to undergo the sentence of corporal punishment about to be inflicted on him"

This sub-section of the Prisons Ordinance has not been amended.

Sub-section 4 of section 27 of the Penal Code (Ordinance No. 10 of 1930) makes similar provision except that the words "Government Medical Officer" are used instead of "Medical Officer".

(2) With the Prisons Ordinance and the Penal Code...

Section 11(1) of the Criminal Procedure Code provides that "No sentence imposed on a native by any subordinate court exceeding.....twelve strokes shall be carried into effect.....until the record of the case or a certified copy thereof has been transmitted to and the sentence has been confirmed by the Supreme Court."

Section 348 of the Criminal Procedure Code provides for suspension of sentence pending appeal.

Ordinance, 1933, see... terminating with your Despatch No. 467 of the 23rd June... there would be less objection to a provision rendering these sentences also subject to confirmation. In the meantime I should prefer, in all the circumstances, to limit present action to that proposed in paragraph 3 above.

5. The Chief Justice is being asked to direct the attention of all magistrates by circular to the need for the exercise of the greatest care in passing sentences of corporal punishment.

SIR

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch No.897 of the 9th December last regarding the Return of Canings carried out in the prisons of this Colony and Protectorate during the six months ended the 30th June, 1932.

In regard to paragraph 2, I have not received any reports of the canings carried out in the prisons during the period in which it would appear that the canings in question were imposed in the following circumstances.

BARBARA DE LAMON

This convict was sentenced to a term of imprisonment of an offence under Section 57 (17) of the Ordinance, for smuggling a blanket out of the prison. The sentence was imposed under Section 61 (1) (a) as the offence in question constituted the convict's eleventh breach of discipline.

BRANA BIN ANIDU

Shortly after his admission to prison this convict was charged with idleness and warned. He was subsequently charged under Section 57(29) with refusing to work and sentenced to a period of reduced diet.

Whilst serving his sentence of reduced diet

he was charged and convicted under Section 100 for eating food assigned to other prisoners, thus evading his sentence of reduced diet.

The Superintendent considered this offence to constitute an aggravated offence and he was accordingly sentenced to corporal punishment under Section 109.

It is pointed out that in regard to the general question much depends upon circumstances such as the general tone of the prison and the possibility that repeated offences by one or two convicts may seriously affect the discipline of the whole prison. The Commissioner is.

of the opinion that the power to award corporal punishment is now seldom abused.

4. I am in general agreement with the views expressed by the Commissioner and I consider that the sentences of caning in the cases of Hjeroge wa Kamau, Abushiri s/c Oladi and Jabu alias Mohamed Hassan were in all the ~~circumstances~~ circumstances imposed with due regard to the relative provisions of the Ordinance governing the award of corporal punishment.

I am, however, prepared to agree that in the case of Swana bin Akidh it is questionable whether the sentence of caning should properly have been imposed, and the Commissioner of Prisons is being instructed to inform the officer concerned accordingly.
