With reference to the late Viscount Long's despatch No. 302 of the 17th April, 1917, I have the honour to inform you that consequent upon the abolition of his office Mr. J. H. Jones, Assistant Linotype Operator, Government Press, has been retrenched and his appointment will terminate with effect from the 1st June, 1933, inclusive.

2. Mr. Jones who is an African serving on Asiatic terms of service, was originally engaged on the 1st April, 1900, as a Junior Press hand in the Government Press. He was promoted to the rank of Compositor on the 1st April, 1906, and to a IV grade Clerkship on the 1st April, 1913. His promotion to the post of III grade clerk (pensionable) was approved with effect from the 1st April, 1917, when his designation was altered to that of the Assistant Linotype Operator in the Government Press. His service has been continuous for pension purposes and I recommend that under Regulation 7 of the Non-European Officers' Pensions Ordinance, 1932, his service may be allowed to count from the date he attained the age of 20 years, viz: 16th April, 1906.



He has exercised his option to receive a gratuity in lieu of a quarter of his pension in accordance with Regulation 13 (2)(a) of the Non-European Officers' Pensions Ordinance, 1932, and he will, therefore, be eligible for a reduced pension at the rate of £ns. 2,432/09 a year together with a gratuity of £ns. 8,106/90. This computation is based on the assumption that you will not withhold your approval to the recommendation contained in paragraph 2 supra.
