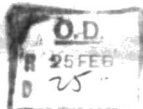

Sir,

I have the honour to refer to Section 697 of the Kenya Land Commission Report on the subject of a proposed exchange of land between Mr. Colvile and the Masai Reserve.

2. The proposal placed before the Land Commission is illustrated on the plan facing page 1196 Vol. II of the "Evidence". It has since transpired, however, that this proposal is not acceptable either to Mr. Colvile or to the Masai. A revised proposal has been submitted with the approval of the Narok Local Native Council, the Narok Local Land Board and Mr. Colvile for an exchange of the whole of farm No. 410/1 for an equal area in the Masai Reserve north of the Marmanet River. The proposal is the same in principle although not in exact detail as that considered by the Commission.

3. Mr. R.W. Hemsted and Captain F.O'B. Wilson, the members of the Commission now resident in the Colony, and the accredited representatives of the White Highlands have no objection to the proposed alteration.

On the advice of Executive Council this small modification, which is illustrated on the attached plan, is submitted for your formal sanction.
