I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch Transport No.107 of the 4th November, from which I note your decision not to press, for the moment, the proposal that the actual rate of contribution to the Renewal Fund should be reduced to a 2% basis.

I observe that in the second paragraph of your despatch you refer to "the full rate of 3.112". The enclosure to my despatch Transport No. 61 of the 25th July indicated that the full rate, as revised by the inclusion in the calculations of long lived assets added since 1930, should now be assessed at 2.95%. take this opportunity of informing you that, in accordance with recommendation 1. of the Renewals Fund Committee, which was approved in your telegram No.7 of the 14th October, the calculations have now been further modified by the substitution of the replacement cost of assets, as estimated in 1935, for the original cost as computed in 1929. The "full life" rate has consequent ly been further reduced to 2.81%, which should henceforward be regarded as the standard figure, subject to future adjustment when lives and assets are recomputed.
