With reference to Kenya Confidential despatch No.55 of the 15th March, 1937, on the subject of the demarcation of Native Reserve boundaries, I have the honour to inform you that, since the date of that despatch, the following work in connection with gazetted boundaries has been performed by the Survey Department:-
