In the petition to the Secretary of State
at No. 1 Wadhawa Khan asks for a pension to be
granted to him. The ground on which this request
is based is that his long and faithful service ought
to deserve fuller recognition than the small gratuity
which has been paid to him. In No. 3 the Governor
points out that in fact the gratuity was generous,
and that Wadhawa Khan has been treated with
exceptional consideration in that he was exempted
from the provisions of Section 5(1)(e) of the Act
