THE NON-EUROPEAN OFFICERS' PENSIONS ORDINANCE 1932.

Owing to certain changes in the nomenclature of posts in the Estimates it is necessary to safeguard the pension rights of the individual holders of these posts who have been accorded pensionable status in the past. EUROPEAN OFFICERS' PENSIONS
ORDINANCE, 1927.PENSIONABLE OFFICERS.

Owing to certain changes having been recently made in the nomenclature of posts and to the creation of certain new posts in the current Estimates it is necessary to safeguard the pension rights of the individual holders of these posts. Under Section 2 of the above Ordinance it is necessary for the approval of Council and the Secretary of State to be given to the gazetting of these offices as pensionable.

The following offices should be declared as "pensionable offices" for the purpose of the European Officers' Pensions Ordinance 1927.

	Director of Surveys.	Formerly "Surveyor General". The more recent title of "Chief Surveyor" has been abolished as from 1st Jan. 1938. Present holder pensionable.
